- †2. ('Papaya Punch' x 'Casanova') is Looye's good yellow
- †3. "Purple Enigma" Un-registered name, cross of 'Calsap' x 'Janet Blair' with purple flowers.
- †4. Sally Perkins, N.H. did this cross originally: "They gave the reddest and latest blooming deciduous azaleas...August."
- †5. Seed has been stratified. Store in fridge in plastic packet as received until March/April then sow in warm soil.
- †6. Liliium seeds may require a warm/ moist period followed by a cold period if there is no germination. Plant cold treated pots outside in spring.
- †7. Magnolia seed has been stratified. Store in fridge in plastic packet as received until March/April then sow in warm soil.
- †8. The specific epithet hispidus (often given incorrectly as hispida or hispidum) refers to the small ribbed fruits which are covered in bristles. The common name "epalette tree" refers to the fringed individual flowers.
- †9. *Xanthoceras sorbifolium* is a small deciduous tree or large multi-stemmed shrub considered rare in America and Europe. Also known as the CHINESE FLOWERING CHESTNUT, it has large white 1" flowers with a red or yellow blotch

at the base. ~ 15 feet, with dark green leaflets. China. Zone 4. Hardy in the North. The flowers, leaves, and fruit are said to have been used as food.

- † 10. The species *M. baileyi* is probably the big perennial blue poppy most familiar to gardeners, although until recently (2009) it had been known for many decades under the name *Meconopsis betonicifolia*. However, the original name, *M. baileyi*, has recently (2009) been restored to this taxon.

NOTES

1. Open-pollinated species, with the exception of a very few, may not come true from seed. Cultivars, with the exception of a few perennials do not come true. Plants from these seeds should be labelled as being "ex" that species or cultivar.

4. When sowing rhododendrons on peat we recommend you sterilize it first. Microwave it for 15 minutes or pour boiling water through it several times. Allow to cool.
